

HMHA Pro Kids Policy

HMHA strongly supports the Pro Kids program and feels it meets the need of allowing children the opportunity to play sports.

To provide privacy and confidentiality to participants in this program HMHA has directed that only their Treasurer and/or Registrar are able to communicate with the Pro Kids organization regarding applications.

Pro Kids covers up to \$300 seasonally per child towards hockey registration for qualified applicants.

Based on current HMHA registration fees that leaves a balance owing from \$5 - \$175, depending on the age of the child.

HMHA executive has authorized the HMHA Treasurer significant leeway to provide parents with a variety of payment options to cover the remaining balance.

Playing on a competitive hockey team is not the mandate for the Pro Kids program therefore try out fees (currently \$50) for competitive teams are not considered covered under HMHA's Pro Kids policy and must be paid in full prior to try outs in order for a player to be placed on the try out list.

HMHA and Pro Kids have jointly agreed to a deadline date for Pro Kids applications, for this hockey season, to be received by Pro Kids by Nov 15, 2016. Application forms are available on the HMHA website under Forms and are to be directed to Paula Kredl. It is preferred that completed applications be dropped off at the Town of Hampton Leisure services office (upstairs at the rink) to the attention of Gena Fowler or Alex Locke.
