Subject: Orange Alert Phase – update

As announced by the Government of New Brunswick earlier today, Zone 2 has moved back to the [Orange Alert Phase](#) in the government Recovery Plan.

This announcement suspends all games for District 5, EDZA South and any other HNB sanctioned teams within this region effective midnight on Friday November 20th. Practices are permitted, which will be required to follow the Guidelines listed in Phase 1 of the [HNB Return to Hockey Guidelines](#), and have a maximum of one team on the ice.

As announced by the Government of New Brunswick on November 19th, District 6, 7 and EDZA East are also in the Orange Alert Phase.

Individuals who reside in Zone 1 and 2 cannot travel outside of the region to participate in HNB sanctioned activities.

Sanctioned on-ice activities in all other areas of New Brunswick are permitted to continue as scheduled.

We will provide further information once it becomes available from the Government of New Brunswick, and we thank everyone in advance for their cooperation as we move through this fluid and very difficult time.
